Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether proposal for four laning of National Highway No. 6 from Dhule to Nandura and for construction of new By-passes in the cities of Jalgaon in Maharashtra is pending with the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the details and the present status of the said proposal;
- (c) whether the work on the said project is being delayed;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefore; and
- (e) the time by which it is likely to be implemented?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R. P. N. SINGH)

(a) to (e): No, Sir. However, under NHDP Phase-III, NHAI has appointed a consultant for carrying out the Feasibility study for 4 laning of NH-6 from Amravati to MH/Gujarat Border (480 Km) including bypasses as required for major towns. The project is likely to be taken up for implementation in 2011-12 on DBFOT pattern.
