**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government proposes to restructure 17 NHA projects in the country which have failed to attract investors;
- (b) if so, the details of such projects for which bids had been invited during the last financial year;
- (c) the number of such projects that have since been restructured to increase their viability, State-wise;
- (d) whether constraints are being faced with regard to acquisition of land; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including the steps taken to remove such hurdles for ensuring timely completion of NH projects?

**Answer**

- (a) to (c) Yes, Madam. List of National Highway (NH) Projects, to be implemented under Public-Private- Partnership (PPP) mode, recently restructured and yet to be awarded is placed at Annexure-I. National Highways Authority of India (NHA) had earlier restructured few projects which have already been awarded, list of which is placed at Annexure-II.
- (d) and (e) Constraints being faced by NHA with regard to acquisition of land for (NH) projects are placed at Annexure-III. The State-wise details of constraints being faced in acquisition of land and the steps taken to remove such hurdles for ensuring timely completion of NH projects are placed at Annexure-IV.
