**Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government provides financial assistance to Sulabh International Social Service Organisation (SISO);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken into account the financial bungs made by the said Non-Governmental Organisation in several schemes while providing financial assistance to it; and
- (d) if so, the details in this regard?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRID. NAPOLEON)

(a) to (d) Under the Self Employment Scheme for Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers (SRMS), the National Safai Karamcharis Finance and Development Corporation (NSKFC) had provided financial assistance of Rs. 50.53 lakh to Sulabh International Social Service Organisation (SISO) through Rajasthan Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Finance & Development Cooperative Corporation Ltd. (RSCFDC) for conducting skill development training for 225 manual scavengers/their dependents, in Rajasthan.

Further, a grant-in-aid of Rs. 5 lakh was provided to SISO for conducting a four days' International Conference on 'World Toilet Summit' at New Delhi.

No incidence of bungling of above mentioned funds released by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment has been noticed.
