Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to extend reservation to poor children in Kendriya Vidyalayas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the proposed reservation will have an adverse impact on the admission of children of Government employees or is it proposed to increase the seats/classes suitably; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. D. PURANDESWARI)

(a) to (d) Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are primarily meant to cater to the educational needs of the children of transferable Central Government employees. In KVs in the civil sector (except those meant for paramilitary forces), there is provision for reservation for SC and ST to the extent of the proportion of their population in the district subject to minimum of 15% and 7½% respectively.
