- (a) & (b): There is no such proposal with the Central Government in the Ministry of Human Resource Development at present .
- (c) & (d): The University Grants Commission (UGC) has reported that UGC is allocating/releasing the funds for Remedial Coaching Schemes for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy-layer) and Minorities under its 'Merged Scheme'. UGC has also established Residential Coaching Academies for Minorities/SC/ST and women in four Central Universities and one Deemed University. Funds allocated and released during XI plan period under the 'Merged Scheme', State- wise are annexed.
