- (a) the details of the functioning and under-construction major power projects in the country along with their installed power generation capacity, sector, project, State and source-wise;
- (b) the estimated cost of these projects and the expenditure incurred on the under construction power projects so far, project-wise;
- (c) the time by which these projects are likely to be commissioned;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to review the work under execution of the ongoing power projects in the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 157 TO BE ANSWERED IN THE LOK SABHA ON 19.11.2010 REGARDING POWER PROJECTS.

(a) to (c) : Sector-wise, State-wise and Source-wise details of the under construction thermal, hydro and nuclear power projects, which are likely to be commissioned during the Eleventh Plan, indicating their installed capacity, estimated cost, expenditure incurred so far and likely year of commissioning are enclosed at Annex-I, II and III, respectively.

Sector-wise, State-wise and Source-wise details of functional thermal, hydro and nuclear power plants in the country are enclosed at Annex-IV, V and VI, respectively.

(d) & (e) : The Government has been regularly monitoring the progress of work for ongoing power projects in the country. Monitoring of power projects are carried out regularly by the Ministry of Power at different levels i.e. by the Central Electricity Authority, by the Ministry of Power through the Power Project Monitoring Panel (PPMP) and the Advisory Group. The Eleventh Plan capacity addition programme is also monitored by the Planning Commission and Cabinet Secretariat.
