- (a)&(b) Out of these forts only Sindhudurg Fort is a protected monument of Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). The repair work at this fort is attended regularly and it is in a good state of preservation. Basic tourist amenities have been provided at the fort to facilitate the tourist.
- (c) Allocation of funds will be decided after approval and allocation of budget to ASI for the financial year 2011-12.
