- (e) if not, the time by which such report is likely to be submitted?

(a) to (e): The Government has been, on the continuous basis, reviewing the security arrangements in the light of the emerging challenges, from time to time. Action is also taken on the suggestions for improvement and facilitating higher levels to improve the internal security situation of the country. One such Task Force was recently constituted in March, 2009 as a follow up to the Conference of Directors General of Police of States and Heads of Central Police Organisations held in November, 2008. However, to divulge terms of references, specific recommendations made by various committees, task forces, etc. on internal security, and action taken thereon, may not be in public interest.
