(a) to (c): Police Training is the responsibility of respective States which establish training facilities, and the Central Government, in order to supplement such efforts, envisages establishment of a Central Academy for Police Training at Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh, inter-alia, for training of trainers, at the cost of Rs. 47.14 crores.
