- (a) whether several cases of crimes against mentally disabled persons by the attendants and policemen have been reported from different parts of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes stringent measures to safeguard such persons; and
- (d) if so, the measures being proposed in this regard?

- (a) & (b): As per the information provided by National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB), no data is maintained centrally.
- (c) & (d): As per the seventh schedule to the Constitution of India "Police" and "Public Order" are State subjects and as such, the primary responsibility of prevention, detection, registration, investigation and prosecution of crime, lies with the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations. However, the Union Government attaches great importance to the matter of prevention and control of crime against mentally disabled persons.
