(a) to (e): Part of Cess on HSD accrued in CRF is earmarked for PMGSY and this is allocated amongst States as per formula given by the Planning Commission for allocation of funds in 2000-01. In addition, the funds for implementation of the programme are received from Plan Assistance, Externally Aided Projects through World Bank & Asian Development Bank and loans raised from National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD). The allocation out of share of Cess received for the programme is normative in nature and additional funds over and above the normative allocation are made available to the States depending upon status of preparedness, the speed of execution of projects in hand and the absorption capacity of the executing agencies.
