(a): Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (IGNOAPS) is a component of National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP). NSAP was transferred to State Plan in 2002-03 and funds are released as Additional Central Assistance (ACA) by the Ministry of Finance to the States as a combined allocation for all the schemes under NSAP together. The funds provided to State of Bihar under NSAP during the last two years and current year is as under:
