CONSTRUCTION OF LINK ROADS IN RAJASTHAN

**Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the State Government of Rajasthan is being requested continuously to construct approach roads to the lands allocated to the persons of Balai Samaj (Scheduled Castes) in Rajasthan including Mudiawas village (Singiyo ki Dhadi) but nothing has been done in this regard so far;
- (b) if so, whether the Union Government intends to take any special cognisance in this regard;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

(a)to(d): The criterion of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is to provide single all weather connectivity to eligible unconnected habitations having population of 500 persons and above in plain areas and 250 persons and above in Hill States, Tribal (Schedule V) areas, desert (Desert Development Programme) Areas and Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected districts as identified by Ministry of Home Affairs.
