PRODUCTIVE EMPLOYMENT TO BPL FAMILIES IN M.P

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the proposal of productive employment to the families living Below Poverty Line (BPL) in Madhya Pradesh is lying pending with the Union Government; and

(b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the action taken by the Union Government thereon?

(a)&(b): Productive employment to the families living Below Poverty Line (BPL) is provided under the major self employment programme of Swarnjayanti Gram Swarojgar Yojana (SGSY)/National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM). Out of total 48 District Rural Development Agencies (DRDAs)/Zilla Prishad(ZPs) in the State of Madhya Pradesh, central releases have been made to 14 DRDAs, proposals of 9 DRDAs are under process and utilisation of 3 DRDAs is lower than the prescribed limit. Proposals from remaining 22 DRDAs are not yet received.
