(a) to (d): As per the decision taken during the meeting of the Governors/Chief Ministers of 7 States affected by Left Wing Extremism held on 14th July 2010, State Governments of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Orissa and West Bengal have constituted Unified Command in their respective States for anti-naxal operations. Assistance is provided to the State Governments in this regard, as and when required.
