The Kargil Review Committee (KRC) submitted its report to the Government on January 07, 2000.

As follow-up to the recommendations of KRC, the Government set up a Group of Ministers (GoM) on April 17, 2000 to study the deficiencies highlighted by KRC in areas relating to intelligence, border management and defence. Though the KRC did not deal with internal security, the GoM considered it necessary to examine this subject as well. The GoM thus set up four Task Forces-one each in the areas of Intelligence Apparatus, Internal Security, Border Management and Defence Management.

The recommendations of the Task Force were incorporated in the report of 'Reforming the National Security System' which was finalized in February, 2001. Recommendations of this report were implemented and contributed substantially in upgradation of the intelligence apparatus.
