(a) to (c): The New Delhi Municipal Council has decided to outsources hardware, and provision of computer teachers in its schools and Navyug Schools run by the Navyug School Education Society (NSES) to M/s. NIIT for imparting quality computer education in these schools. On the said project, an annual expenditure of Rs.16,86,072 is incurred by NSES.
