Extant rules provide for giving compensation to the dependents of persons dying in train accidents. However, in exceptional circumstances and on humanitarian grounds jobs have been provided. As regards number of the dependents who have been provided employment on the railways during the last three years, the information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the Sabha.
