Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways have any proposal to expand and modernise Shujalpur, Shajapur and Maksi railway stations;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith expenditure likely to be involved therein; and
- (c) the time by which the said work is likely to be completed?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c): Upgradation/modernisation of amenities at station is a continuous process.

Shujalpur station was identified for development under Modern Station scheme. Addition/alteration of Station building for Passenger Reservation System (PRS) office (Cost approximately `12 Lakhs), provision of booking window and approach road work (Cost approximately `23 Lakhs) have been completed. Works relating to Raising of platform Nos.2 & 3 from Medium Level to High Level (Cost approximately `30 Lakhs), extension of Foot-Over-Bridge, providing Pay & Use Toilet and improvement to platform surface (Cost approximately `50 Lakhs), improvement to circulating area, waiting hall, Booking Office etc. (Cost approximately `41 Lakhs) at this station have been taken up for early completion.

At Shajapur station, work of extension of platform for 24/26 coaches trains for approximately `128 Lakhs has been taken up for early completion.

Maksi station is 'D' Category station where essential passenger amenities have been provided as per norms commensurate with present level of passenger traffic.
