(a) & (C) Government is aware of the use of hazardous chemicals in different sectors of economic activity including Small Scale Industries. As per Schedule-I of the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989 notified by the Government of India under the Environment (Protection Act), 1986, a total of 684 chemicals have been listed as hazardous chemicals. Government has taken steps to ensure adequate safety norms and these measures are envisioned in Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989, Chemical Accident (Emergency, Planning, Preparedness and Response) Rules, 1996 and Factories Act, 1948.
