(a) whether the Government has any proposal to set up a nodal body for broadcasting of news in the event of major crisis;

(b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the other functions of the said body;

(c) the present status of the proposal; and

(d) the time by which the said body is likely to be set up and functional?

(a) to (d): At present, there is no proposal under consideration of the Government to set up a nodal body for broadcasting of news in the event of major crisis.

The Government has outlined a 'Standard Operating Procedure' (SOP) to facilitate the flow of information to media during crisis situations. The Standard Operating Procedure has been designed after consultations with various stakeholders to specify steps that are required to be taken with reference to media facilitation at the Central and State levels. Salient features of the Standard Operating Procedure' for Media Facilitation are annexed.
