- (a) whether the Government has assessed the total production and consumption of cotton in the country before allowing export of cotton;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the total demand and supply of cotton in the country and the total cotton exported by the country during the last three years?

(a) to (c): Yes Madam. Cotton Advisory Board (CAB) met on 27.8.2010 and estimated production of cotton at 325 lakh bales and consumption at 266 lakh bales. The supply for the year 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10 was 369 lakh bales, 335.50 lakh bales and 373.50 lakh bales respectively. Total demand including exports for the year 2007-08, 2008-09 and 2009-10 was 326 lakh bales, 264 lakh bales and 333 lakh bales respectively.
