Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has proposed/proposes to provide financial assistance to various newspapers, news agencies and private channels to bail them out from recession;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government also proposes to help/assist the small news papers by taking services of different news agencies;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor and the other corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

(a) & (b):

The Government announced a fiscal stimulus package for the print media on account of economic slowdown which was valid from 27th February, 2009 to 31st December, 2009. It included the following:-

(i) Waiver of 15% Agency Commission on DAVP advertisements.

(ii) 10% increase in the DAVP rates (paid as a separate element and designated as 'special relief') subject to documentary proof of loss of revenue in the non-governmental advertisements as compared to the same period in the previous year.

(c) There is no such proposal.

(d) Does not arise.

(e) The Government does not interfere in the internal affairs of newspapers establishments or news agencies given the policy of the Government of non- interference in the affairs of media.
