Answer

Minister of State in the Ministry of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

- (a) The power generation project at Palatana in South Tripura is being implemented by ONGC Tripura Power Company Ltd. (OTPC), a special purpose Joint Venture company of ONGC, Infrastructure Leasing & Financial Services Ltd. (IL&FS) and Govt. of Tripura. The project is presently under construction.
- (b) Total generation capacity of the project is 726.6 MW.
- (c) to (f) No, Madam. The first unit of the project is scheduled to be commissioned in Dec., 2011 and the second unit in March, 2012.
