(a) the number of deep water drilling rigs owned by the Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC);

(b) the date since when the rigs have been hired and the hired charges being paid by ONGC alongwith the name of owner company/individual of the said rigs;

(c) the quantum of work undertaken by the rigs alongwith the quantity of oil drilled;

(d) whether a number of new rigs have been hired, although the existing rigs are lying idle;and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

(a) ONGC owns one deep water rig named Sagar Vijay. Additionally, ONGC has also charter hired 4 deep water drilling rigs, out of which 2 are in operation (DDKG-1 & Disc 7 Seas) while other 2 (Platinum Explorer & Sevan Driller-II) are likely to be deployed by 31.12.2010.
