(a) & (b): No Madam. Cost of production of urea depends upon the price of feedstock of gas, LNG, Naptha etc. and that of P&K fertilizers depends upon the inputs such as rock phosphate, ammonia, phosphoric acid, sulphur etc. For Phosphatic and Potassic (P&K) fetilizers, production in the Country is largely import dependent.
