the extent to which the renovation and modernization of various power plants in the country are likely to be completed and also the extent of the power generation capacity likely to be enhanced by the loan approved by the World Bank recently?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI BHARATSINH SOLANKI)

The World Bank on 18th June, 2009, has approved a loan of USD 180 million and a Global Environment Facility (GEF) grant equivalent to USD 45.4 million for the rehabilitation of the following Coal Fired Stations in India:

(i) Bandel (Unit-5)/West Bengal.

(ii) Koradi (Unit-6)/Maharashtra.

(iii) Panipat (Unit-3&4)/Haryana.

The expected period for completion of the work and after completion of energy efficient Renovation & Modernization of the units, the expected power generation enhanced would be as under:-
