(a) & (b): The Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Legal Affairs in collaboration with the Bar Council of India, National Law University, Delhi has organized a two day National Consultation for Second Generation Reforms in Legal Education on 1st & 2nd May, 2010 at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi. It was resolved in the National Consultation that there will be a National Law University in every State.
