- (c) whether Dausa to Gangapur(Rajasthan) railway line has already been sanctioned;
- (d) if so, the details thereof alongwith the amount allocated for this rail line; and
- (e) the time by which the said work is likely to be completed?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Survey has been conducted for Gauge Conversion of Dholpur- Sirmuttra narrow gauge section and its extension upto Gangapur City via Karali.
- (c): Yes, Madam.
- (d) & (e): The latest anticipated cost of this 93 Km long new line project is Rs 410.08 crore. A sum of Rs 10 crore has been provided for the work during 2009-10. The work will be progressed as per the availability of resources.
