- (a) the details of the Centrally Sponsored Schemes being implemented together with the fresh schemes proposed for agricultural development in the country, particularly in Maharashtra during the last three years, State-wise;
- (b) the details of the achievements made in this regard during the aforesaid period, State-wise; and
- (c) the amount of funds utilised under those schemes so far, State-wise?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (PROF. K.V. THOMAS)

(a) to (c): The major Centrally Sponsored Schemes being implemented by the Department of Agriculture & Cooperation for agricultural development in the country including Maharashtra are -

- (i) Macro Management of Agriculture;
- (ii) National Food Security Mission;
- (iii) National Horticulture Mission;
- (iv) Micro Irrigation;
- (v) Integrated Scheme of Oilseeds, Pulses, Oil Palm & Maize (ISOPOM);
- (vi) Support to State Extension Programmes for Extension Reforms;
- (vii) National Bamboo Mission;
- (viii) Technology Mission on Cotton; and
- (ix) National Project on Management of Soil Health and Fertility. In addition to these, Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana is being implemented as a State Plan scheme.

The Scheme-wise and State-wise details of funds released and utilized and per cent of achievements during the last three years (2007-08 to 2009-10) are given in Annexure - I (i to x).
