(a) to (c): As per the report 'India: Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions 2007', published by Ministry of Environment & Forests, the GHG emissions in Agriculture Sector has reduced from 27.6% in 1994 to 17.6% in 2007 (of the total GHG emissions) without impacting food security. This has been possible due to improved agronomic and live-stock management, adoption of precision farming, farm mechanization etc.
