Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether due to non-availability of Railway conveyance there is acute shortage of fertilizer in Kerala;
- (b) whether the Railways have examined the feasibility of having a rail head point at Kazhakkuttam railway station as per the request of the State Government; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Railways in this regard?

- (a) No, Madam.
- (b) and (c): Railways have not received any request from State Govt. for a goods shed at Kazhakkuttam station. However, the issue has been examined by the Railways independently and it is found that provision of a goods shed at this station is not justified due to very low traffic projections.
