(a) to (d): Organisation of Pharmaceutical Producers of India(OPPI) an association consisting of MNC companies had a meeting with the PMO regarding IPR issues that hamper the functioning of development of innovation and research based pharmaceutical companies in India and sought Government's support for enforcement of IPR. Subsequently, as directed by the Prime Minister's Office(PMO), the views of concerned Ministries of Health and Family Welfare, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion and Department of Legal Affairs were obtained on the issues raised by OPPI and the same have been sent to the PMO with the comments of the Department.
