STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN PARTS (a), (b), (c) and (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 272, DUE FOR REPLY ON 29.11.2010, REGARDING BACKWARD REGIONS GRANT FUND

- (a) & (b): In respect of the Backward Regions Grant Fund (BRGF) Programme, the Government of India had set the financial targets of Rs. 4670 crore in each of the last 3 years at Budget Estimate (BE) stage which were subsequently revised to Rs. 3600 crore, Rs. 3890 crore and Rs. 3670 crore in 2007-08, 2008-09 and 2009-10, respectively, at the Revised Estimate (RE) stage. The Ministry has achieved the financial targets set at the Revised Estimate stage during the three years. The State-wise position is at Annex.
- (c) & (d): The untied grants under the Development Grant component of the BRGF are used by the Panchayats and Municipalities for executing developmental works. In case the works are outside the administrative and financial powers of Panchayats and Municipalities concerned, they can get the works done through competent implementing agencies.
