(a) (b) & (C) Delhi Milk Scheme has issued permission to the respective booth concessionaires to operate PCO/STD phone. During the current calendar year 15 reports were received against booths selling non-permitted products e.g. fruits/vegetables, stationery items, grocery items, other general merchandise and running coffee machine. On verification through the DMS internal monitoring mechanism, show cause notices were issued in 14 cases. In three cases booths of the concessionaries who failed to mend their ways, were cancelled.
