Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government has any proposal to set up car production units/ industries of various companies in the backward districts of Tamil Nadu by giving tax rebate/concession to create more job directly and indirectly and easily export such manufactured cars from the nearest airport and seaport;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c) : As per data maintained by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) and information furnished by Society of Indian Automobile manufacturers Association (SIAM), many car manufacturers have already established their manufacturing plants in Tamil Nadu. Some of the companies having manufacturing plants in the State of Tamil Nadu are as under:-
