## Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to discontinue Blackberry services in the country;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (d) the number of connections provided by various mobile companies during the last three years and the current year?

## **Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SACHIN PILOT)

- (a) Blackberry services have not been banned so far.
- (b) & (c) Security Agencies can intercept and monitor voice, SMS and individual customer email. However, Government is engaged with Research in Motion (RIM), the provider of Blackberry phone services to find out a solution to the interception and monitoring of messenger chat and enterprise email using Blackberry phone.
