- (a) and (b): As per information available with the Indian Bureau of Mines, details of major minerals produced in the country, including Rajasthan during each of last three years and the current year, revenue earned and employment provided in mining, are given in Annexure I, II and III. District wise details of mineral occurrence are available in the National Mineral Inventory which is a published document of Indian Bureau of Mines, and is updated at five year intervals.
- (c) to (e): Instances of illegal mining, including Rajasthan and Jharkhand, have been brought to the attention of the Government. Details of illegal mining cases detected by the State Governments and action taken by the State Governments are given in Annexure IV. The Central Government has taken several measures to curb illegal mining, details of which are given in Annexure V.
