(a) to (c) Construction of over-bridges wherever required are being constructed as part of upgradation to 4 lane/6 lane on national highways under the National Highway Development Project (NHDP). Under non-NHDP, a proposal of land acquisition for an over bridge at Km.93 on NH-96 near Chilbila in Pratapgarh District of Uttar Pradesh, is included in the Annual Plan 2010-11. The state PWD have been requested to submit the land acquisition estimate for the aforesaid proposal based on the rates of the Revenue department.
