- (a) whether a proposal to increase the number of schools for child labourers in the country is under the consideration of Government;
- (b) if so, the broad outlines of the said proposal; and
- (c) the total number of child labourers these schools will have the capacity to admit?

(a) to (c): Under the Scheme of National Child Labour Project (NCLP) schools are sanctioned to the districts identified for implementation of the scheme based on the details survey report and recommendations made by the district Collector & Chairman of the Project Society. Increase in the number of the schools is on going process. As per the NCLP guidelines each school has to accommodate 50 children withdrawn from work.
