- (a) whether the Government has decided to roll out a national retirement plan that promises a fixed income to millions of workers in the unorganised sector;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether State Governments have been consulted in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof with the result achieved so far?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI HARISH RAWAT)

(a) to (d): No such proposal is under consideration of the Government. However, Government is implementing the Indira Gandhi National Old Pension Scheme for all citizen who are above the age of 65 years and living below poverty line and Swavalamban scheme to provide pension to unorganized workers whose contribution to New Pension Scheme (NPS) is minimum Rs.1000 and maximum Rs.12000 per annum.
