- (d) whether the Government is aware of the long pending demand for opening up of an Employees Provident Fund (EPF) Office at Hosur, Tamil Nadu; and
- (e) if so, the detailed action taken thereon?

- (a) to (c): Public Provident Fund is applicable to all citizens, Including unogranised sector.
- (d) & (e): As per the decision of the Executive Committee, Central Board of Trustee, Employees` Provident Fund in its 63rd meeting held on 10.11.2008, the norms for opening of field offices of the Employees` Provident Fund Organisation are being revisited. Once norms are approved, proposal for opening of field offices would be considered.
