- (a) whether frequency has been allocated for setting up of Community Radio Stations in various parts of the country including Madhya Pradesh ;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefore; and
- (d) the time by which the said frequency is likely to be allocated?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (DR. S. JAGATHRAKSHKAN)

- (a) Yes, sir. WPC Wing of Ministry of Communication & IT has allocated frequency for setting up of Community Radio Stations in various parts of the country including Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) to (d) Frequencies 90.4 MHz, 90.8 MHz, 91.2 MHz and 107.8 MHz have been earmarked and allocated for Community Radio Service all over India on frequency reuse basis.
