(a),(b)&(c): The optimum capacity utilization norm for storage given by the Bureau of Industrial Costs and Prices(BICP) is 75%. However, no set norms/criteria are followed in this regard since utilization depends upon various factors such as procurement, offtake and movement of foodgrains.
