- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Railways revised the estimate of these projects; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. This is a sanctioned new line project from Kadur to Sakleshpur(93 km) and in the first phase, work has been taken up from Kadur to Chikmagalur. Six railway stations are involved in this first phase of this work. Earthwork and minor bridge
- (c) & (d): The revised estimate for the project has not been prepared.
