- (b) & (c): Work was sanctioned during Works Programme of 2001-02 but could not be taken in hand, as State Govt. had not assigned priority. Detailed Estimate for approaches has not been furnished by State Govt. inspite of Railway's pursuasion. Railway has allocated Rs.2cr. during 2009-10 for its portion of work.
- (c): Cannot be fixed in view of above.
