(a) to (f): Allotment of land for schools is generally done by the State Governments and is governed by the rules and guidelines of respective State Governments. In case of any violation of allotment conditions by the lessee, the State Governments take action as per the lease conditions. Details about compliance or otherwise of the guidelines are maintained by the respective State Governments and not by the Central Government.
