(a) to (e): During the XI Five Year Plan seven new IIMs have been set up at Shillong (Meghalaya), Rohtak (Haryana), Raipur (Chhattisgarh), Ranchi (Jharkhand), Tiruchirappalli (Tamil Nadu), Kashipur (Uttarakhand) & Udaipur (Rajasthan). Out of this all are operational except the IIMs at Kashipur & Udaipur where PGP classes will commence from the academic year 2011-12.
