(a) to (c) There are 19 new projects of Maharashtra which are under appraisal with the Central Appraising Agencies (CAA). The Ministry of Water Resources during has considerably increased frequency of the meeting of the Advisory Committee of Ministry of Water Resources on Irrigation, Flood Control & Multipurpose Projects which accord techno-economic clearance to the projects and it is for the State Governments to submit satisfactory compliances of the observations of the CAA so that project proposal could be put up before above stated Advisory Committee for approval/clearance.
