VACANT POSTS IN BUREAU OF CIVIL AVIATION SECURITY

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether some top posts in the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security are lying vacant since long;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the main reasons for not filling up these posts in time; and
- (d) the steps taken/being taken to fill these posts on top priority basis?

Answer

MINISTER OF OVERSEAS INDIAN AFFAIRS & MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI VAYALAR RAVI)

(a)&(b): Yes, Madam. One post of Joint Commissioner of Security (Civil Aviation) [Jt.COSA] and one post of Additional Commissioner of Security (Civil Aviation) [Addl.COSCA] are lying vacant in the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security [BCAS].

(C)&(d) Timely necessary action to fill up these post has already been taken. After selection by the Selection Committee and recommendation of the Hon'ble Minister of Civil Aviation, the proposed to fill up the post of Jt.COSCA has been sent to DOPT for approval of Appointment committee of Cabinet [ACC].

For vacant post of Addl.COSCA, Ministry of Home Affairs has sent a panel consisting name of one officer only. MHA has been requested to furnish more names of eligible officers, so that a selection can be made amongst them.
